Mission: To bring together the collective voices of consumers, family members, advocates and providers to educate the public, to engage policy makers and to increase the resources necessary to address the Commonwealth's human service needs and to improve the mental health and well-being of all Kentuckians.

In April of 1982, there was a revolution in the mental health community of Kentucky. Representatives of nine mental health organizations formed the Kentucky Mental Health Coalition (KMHC) to support collaboration and to speak with one advocacy voice. Since its inception, KMHC has broadened its mission and includes nearly 90 Consumer, Family, Provider and Advocacy organizations as well as individual supporters.

By the same token, no member organization may let their individual opinion be called that of the Coalition. Thus, membership in KMHC in no way impinges on the ability of any member organization to adopt its own position/action on any given issue. Individuals who are interested in the coalition's activities are encouraged to join as sponsoring individuals and to attend and participate at meetings, but are not authorized to vote, unless they are the designated voting representative of a member organization.
